How To Prepare For The Service



KITCHEN

- Clean all surfaces, including countertops, tables, and appliances, to remove crumbs and food residues.
- Store all food in airtight containers, including pantry items and pet food.
- Empty kitchen garbage bins daily and clean them to remove residue.
- Repair leaks and dry sinks and counters completely.
- Scrub stovetops and areas prone to grease buildup.



BATHROOM

- Clean sinks, counters, and other surfaces to remove any residue.
- Repair any leaks or dripping faucets.
- Dry sinks, bathtubs, and showers completely after use.
- Store toiletries and personal care items in sealed containers.
- Keep trash bins emptied and clean to avoid attracting ants.



GENERAL HOME AREAS

- Keep all food and drinks out of bedrooms and living areas.
- Vacuum and mop floors to remove crumbs and debris.

PHARAOH ANT TREATMENT

TREATMENT PREPARATION FORM

Following Treatment for at least 4 weeks:

- Monitor ant activity and note areas where bait is being taken.
- Avoid cleaning near bait stations to prevent disturbing the bait.
- Replenish bait stations as needed to ensure they remain accessible to ants.
- **Do not use sprays or kill visible ants to allow the bait to work effectively.**
- Inspect common ant trails and nesting areas for decreased activity over time.
- Report continued high activity to your pest control professional.
- Remove bait stations only if no visible ant activity is observed for at least 7 days.
- Perform a deep clean of treated areas after the baiting program is complete to remove any remaining bait or residue.
